



Export a project as an ePub

You can export a Wixie project as an ePub.


Click the **Send** button on the toolbar.



Choose **Export ePub** and select **Single-Page Layout**.

Choose **Export ePub** and select **Two-Page Layout**, if you want the page curl transition effect. Be sure to use a portrait orientation on your Wixie pages.


You will see the Export an ePub dialog.



Click the **OK** button.

You will see the Save As dialog.

Type a name for the file and choose a saving location.



Click the **Save** button.

The project will be saved as an ePub.

Ideas for Sharing

You can save an ePub anywhere, but if you save to a Google Drive or Dropbox account you can more easily move the file to another device like an iPad.



Share this folder with your students to make it easy to publish their work and share with each other. This way, students can author stories and nonfiction that will be read and used by their classmates.

Make the folder public in your Google Drive or Dropbox account to give student work an even wider audience.

Sharing settings

Visibility options:

-  **Public on the web**
Anyone on the Internet can find and access. No sign-in required.
-  **Anyone with the link**
Anyone who has the link can access. No sign-in required.
-  **Specific people**
Shared with specific people.

Create a link on your school or classroom website to share student writing with parents and community members. Advertise the link and the public folder so that student work has an even wider audience.

You may even find that you need to create lots of subfolders to organize writing by genre and topic!

Since most digital library systems won't let you upload student-created eBooks, this is a great way to make your own digital library collection!
